Welcome to the Creating a Glossary strategy!

A glossary is a list of vocabulary words with definitions.

This strategy shows you how to create a list of vocabulary words from your reading, and then add definitions so you can learn what the words mean.

It also shows you how to study the words so you can learn them well.

Your glossary should include words you don't know, and important words that you might need for a test.

This strategy is useful when:

- You're reading something on a computer
- You don't know all the words
- And, some of the words are really important to learn

The Creating a Glossary strategy has four steps

- 1. Make a Model
- 2. Add the Words
- 3. Define the Words
- 4. Study the Words

For this strategy you'll be using an outliner as well as the dictionary and a translation tool.
