Creating a Glossary Strategy Video 1 - Step 1

TEACHER

Hi! Welcome to Step 1 of the Creating a Glossary strategy. Step 1 is: Make a Model...

In this step you'll make a model for your glossary. You will follow the model each time you add words and definitions to your glossary.

To make a model, create a topic in your outline called 'Word'

STUDENT

OK, I'm in my outliner, now I need to make a topic... and call it Word...

TEACHER

Next, you need to make a subtopic called Definition.

STUDENT

OK, now for my subtopic...Definition.

TEACHER

If you know another language and think it might help you learn new words in English, then you should add another subtopic called Translation.

STUDENT

Hmm, I think it'll be helpful to add another subtopic for a translation of the word too.

...and I'll title it Translation...

TEACHER

Great! You just completed the first step of the Create a Glossary strategy: Make a Model! You will use this model each time you add a word to your glossary.

Now you're ready to move on to Step 2 of the Creating a Glossary strategy – Add Words!
