

# Illustrating Your Glossary Strategy

## Video 3 - Step 3

### **TEACHER**

Welcome to Step 3 of the Illustrating your Glossary strategy!  
Step 3 is Resize and Repeat.

In this step you will resize your image to make it fit into the glossary.  
Then you will move on to the next word that needs an image.

First, to resize your image: select it. This means click on it so you see the blue dots.

Then, click and drag one corner to make the image smaller.  
Continue making it smaller until the image is about the size of playing card.

### **STUDENT**

Ok, here's the image I just added. Wow – it is pretty big!  
First I select it... Then I click on a corner...  
And now I'll drag it to make it smaller. There – now it is about the size of a playing card.

It definitely fits into my glossary better. And I can see both the definition and the image at the same time – that helps.

### **TEACHER**

Great job! Now you're ready to repeat steps 1 and 2 for each word in your glossary that needs an image.
