Hi and welcome to the introduction video for the Illustrating your Glossary strategy!

In this strategy, you will learn how to add images to your glossary. Sometimes having an image will help you **understand the meaning** of a word better than just having a definition. Sometimes having an image will help you **remember** the word better.

In this strategy you will add images to some of the words in your glossary. You will be the one selecting which words need an image.

This strategy is useful when:

- You've created a glossary.
- Images will help you **understand** what the words mean.
- Images will help you **remember** what the words mean.

The Illustrating your Glossary strategy has three steps

- 1. Select and Space
- 2. Choose and Add
- 3. Resize and Repeat
